

HOW TO ENTER THE LOTTERY

Y2Y does not give away any beds at the door. Winning lottery numbers will be posted on the shelter door every day. You may call to check results any time between 8:50 a.m. - 9:45 a.m. or after 7:00 p.m.

TO LOTTERY FOR A 30-DAY BED
Call Y2Y in the morning 8:00 a.m. - 8:45 a.m.

To find out if you have a bed, call back **after 8:50 a.m**. or come to the entrance of the shelter, where we will post the winning lottery number.

TO LOTTERY FOR A 1-NIGHT BED
Call Y2Y in the evening 9:00 p.m. - 9:30 p.m.

To find out if you have a bed, call back **after 9:35 p.m.** You must arrive at the shelter by 10:15 p.m. to claim your bed.
