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Workshop Descriptions

Climate Change Introduction

Learn about the basics of climate change through a categories game and a greenhouse gas experiment.

Oceans Rising

Learn about oceans rising through a trivia bingo game and an erosion experiment using candy and water.

Fast Fashion

Learn about fast fashion through a word hunt game and transform an old shirt into a mask.

How YOU Can Help

Learn ways you can help stop climate change through a broken telephone game and an activity involving making a story together. Includes an optional arts and crafts dice making!

Climate Policy

Learn about climate policy through the game taboo and a legislation simulation where students will investigate a variety of ways to help stop climate change.
