




Two types of survivorcentered groups

How much does it cost?

Like all of TNLR's services, participating in a support group is free. You wil need a phone that supports conference calling.

What are support groups like?

Support groups are confidential weekly calls facilitated by 2 trained TNLR staff or volunteers with no pre-determined agenda. It's a space for survivors to connect, ask questions, and offer mutual support.

Is it really confidential?

What happens in support group stays in support group. But we hope you feel empowered to take what you learn into the rest of your life. Call our hotline to learn more about confidentiality.



What is the time comittment?

Like all of TNLR's services, participating in a support group is free. You will need a phone and mobile plan that supports conference calling.

What can I talk about?
