The MBTA Income-Eligible Reduced Fare program is designed to help you get **half-off regular fares on the Commuter Rail, Subway, Bus, Ferry, and The Ride.**

Eligibility:

- **Age:** You must be 18 to 64 years old
- **Residency:** You must live in Massachusetts
- **Be enrolled** in one of the following state assistance programs:
 - Emergency Aid to the Elderly, Disabled & Children (EAEDC)
 - MASSGrant
 - MassHealth
 - Mass Health Limited Plus Children's Medical Security Plan (CMSP)
 - MassHealth Standard
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - Transitional Aid to Families with Dependent Children (TAFDC)

How to Sign Up:

Call or email us to see if you qualify and set up an appointment — we're here to assist you with the application. Apply in-person at one of our partner locations, available in: **Avon, Boston, Cambridge, Chelsea, Fall River, Fitchburg, Gloucester, Haverhill, Lawrence, Lowell, New Bedford, Peabody, Quincy, and Somerville.**

You must bring:

- Government-issued photo ID **AND:**
- A benefit enrollment letter with your name from the last 3 months **OR**
- A screenshot of your enrollment with your name and active status **OR**
- A letter or screenshot from the MassAid portal from the current school year
